



Vehicle Storage Guidelines

When arranging to store a vehicle at a SpareBox Storage facility, these general vehicle guidelines apply. Always refer to the rental agreement for complete details.

- Vehicles must be insured.
- Vehicles must be in drivable and in working order unless vehicle is trailered.
- The make, model, year, and color of the vehicle must be provided.
- No vehicles that are unsightly, deteriorating, or in disrepair.
- No significant maintenance or repairs may be performed on the vehicle at the facility.
- In addition to the above points, if a vehicle, trailer, boat, or RV is stored in an outside parking lot:
 - Tires must be in reasonable, working order and must remain inflated. Any vehicle with flat tires will be required to repair and/or reinflate.
 - **A designated space can only hold one vehicle, unless otherwise specified such as a truck and trailer or truck and boat trailer combo. Combination of the two must not use more space than allotted area permits.**
 - In the event of an emergency, SpareBox Storage reserves the right to relocate the vehicle to a different area of the facility without notice.
- Where power is available, tenants may utilize power only to trickle charge batteries. Power is not intended to run any other items within the RV/Camper/Trailer.
- If a motorized vehicle such as an automobile, motorcycle, boat, snow mobile, or wave runner, or any other motorized means of transport, is stored inside a storage unit:
 - The motorized vehicle must not leak liquids/fluids onto storage unit floor. If liquids/fluids from vehicle leak in the unit, the customer will reimburse SpareBox Storage for all expenses in accordance with disposal applicable to hazardous material laws.
 - Remove as much fuel from the fuel tank as possible prior to storing.

If a customer is in default of the Vehicle Agreement, SpareBox Storage may, without incurring any liability, have any vehicle being stored by the customer towed at the customer's expense in accordance with state lien law.

FOR RV/BOAT/TRAILER EXCLUSIVE SITES: These sites will be designated as exclusively RV/Boat/Camper and Recreational trailer sites.

- No vehicle other than a recreational vehicle/trailer/camper or boat is permitted in these spaces.
- Tenants will **not** be allowed to park their car/truck in the RV space while utilizing their recreational vehicle or boat.
